Dear Families,

This letter is to give you prior knowledge about important information and process that you will need to know prior to booking your child/ren for the upcoming April 2022 Vacation Care.

Listed below is information regarding excursions that we will be taking the children on during the April 2022 Vacation Care.

In order to make an informed decision in relation to your Child participating in these activities; please carefully read all the information below detailing the activity and the date of the event, as well as the information which will follow shortly regarding the importance of returning the Vacation Care booking forms, including parental consent.

A risk assessment will be carried out before children are taken outside the service premises on an excursion. Prior authorisation must also be obtained from parents or other authorised nominees.

The first excursion will be for Preps -Year2, they will be attending Lone Pines Koala Sanctuary, Fig Tree Pocket on the 4 April 2022. An extra added charge of \$25 will apply to this excursion.

(This extra charge will be reduced according to your CCS% and hours of eligibility)

Excursion two will be for Years 3 -6 going to Raby Bay Foreshore Park, Cleveland for a fun day of water sports, on the 13 April 2022. An extra added charge of \$25 will apply to this excursion.

(This extra charge will be reduced according to your CCS% and hours of eligibility)

Vacation Care fee is \$49 per child a day, this includes all meals & Incursions (a pack lunch is required for excursions).

Care will still be available as normal at the service on the days the excursions are planned.

The reasons for the separate excursions are....

- different activities are appropriate for different age-groups
- numbers on the day will not need to be capped. Therefore, no child will miss out on the opportunity to attend an excursion.
- the service will remain open for care
- children **NOT** wanting to go on any of the excursions will be able to remain at the service and an alternative program will be provided

If your child/ren will be attending the upcoming holidays you will need to complete the Vacation Care enrolment forms. If booking via the XPLOR APP, you are still required to complete and return the Vacation Care enrolment forms to OSHC.
