



MSS UNIFORM DRESS CODE

It is a school expectation that all parents cooperate in the shared responsibility of students following the school's uniform dress code by wearing the **full uniform** at all times whilst attending and/or representing the school (including but not limited to excursions, school photos etc).

The Moggill State School P&C supports a uniform dress code for Moggill State School students because it assists in providing a safe and supportive teaching and learning environment by:

- Ready identification of students and non-students at school or on excursions etc;
- Eliminating distraction of competition in dress, quality or fashion at school;
- Fostering a sense of pride and school spirit; and
- Complying with Education Queensland General Provisions Act 2006 and the Sun Safety Strategy.

The purchase of the school uniform can be done directly at the Uniform Shop or:

The Uniform shop is staffed by a convenor and volunteers from the P&C. Any profits made directly benefit the school through P&C projects.

NON-COMPLIANCE for not wearing the school uniform:

- Students will receive a reminder/warning for the uniform infringement;
- If a student persistently fails to wear the full uniform, parents will be contacted and appropriate resolution/mediation strategies discussed.
- Students may be offered loan clothing for the day if clothing worn to school is inappropriate.

UNIFORM:

- It is expected that parents will name **ALL** items of clothing for easy identification and return.
- There is a 'No hat, No play' policy.
- The length of the uniform must be no shorter than mid-thigh.
- Lycra pants/skins or similar can only be worn underneath the uniform and **must not** be seen.
- Socks must be short in length.
- No hoodies are to be worn.
- Brightly coloured or fluorescent shoes or shoelaces are not permitted.

GROOMING AND JEWELLERY:

- Jewellery is restricted to one watch and one pair of sleepers or plain round/square studs.
- Medical / religious necklaces or bracelets may only be worn with Principal's approval.
- No other jewellery or piercings can be worn including but not limited to facial, nose rings and the like.
- No makeup or nail polish is to be worn.
- Hair that is longer than shoulder length must be tied back/up to keep hair off the student's face and to minimise the risk of head lice.
- Hair accessories should be school colours/natural tones.
- Hair styles should be conventional with natural colours and tones. Hair styles not permitted, include but not limited to unnatural hair colouring, undercuts, mohawks or tracks.

If family / medical / financial hardship impacts on a student's ability to wear the school uniform, parents should liaise with the Principal.
