- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN Upper Two Bands in Year 3 & 5 Numeracy, Reading and Writing
- Increase the percentage of Year 1-6 students achieving at an 'A' and 'B' standard or above for English, Mathematics and Science in the Semester Two reporting period.
- Develop teachers' understanding of the Australian Curriculum through planning, teaching and assessing
- Create successful transitions to school for Prep students
- Sustain productive partnerships with parents and the wider school community

Our initiatives include

- Providing professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understanding of the Australian Curriculum
- Employing a Head of Curriculum (HOC)
- Developing a case management program across the school to focus on student academic achievement
- Coordinating a community Playgroup program one day per week
- Employing a Community Liaison Officer to strengthen community partnerships, market and promote the school and improve levels of communication
- Providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards
- Literacy and Numeracy Intervention programs delivered by trained teacher aides
